

## **Fundraising Day in New York**

### **FAQs**

Q. Where and when can I check in?

A. Check-in is not necessary if you received your badge via mail. If your badge did not arrive in time, please check-in between 7:30 AM – 8:30 AM at the 6<sup>th</sup> floor registration desk. The first session of the day begins at 8:45 AM.

Q. My colleague can't attend, can I take their place?

A. Yes! All substitutions will be made on-site. Please bring your colleague's badge and/or registration receipt for on-site substitutions.

Q. Is sign-up required to attend the different sessions offered at FRDNY?

A. No, pre-registration required. You are welcome to attend any session throughout the day.

Q. Can I receive Continuing Education Credit for FRDNY?

A. Yes, you can receive up to 5 CFRE credits for attending the programming at FRDNY. Please be sure to use the tracking page included in the printed program to keep track of your CFRE credit.

Q. I ordered a special meal, where can I pick up my special meal ticket?

A. Special meal tickets can be picked up during the 10 AM coffee break at the registration desk located on the 6<sup>th</sup> floor. Please note, special meals MUST be ordered by June 8<sup>th</sup>. Special meal tickets will not be provided to individuals who did not pre-order their meals.

Q. What is the *SolutionsCenter*?

A. More than eighty organizations – businesses, consulting services, educational programs – display their products and services in a large exhibit area.

Q. What is Career Mentoring?

A. Experienced professionals meet one-on-one for 30 minutes with conference participants to answer questions regarding career aspirations, resumes, or other professionally-related issues. You may stop by to see if there are any open appointments. Career Mentoring will be located at the rear right of the 5<sup>th</sup> floor *SolutionsCenter*.

Q. Will coffee, tea and water be served throughout the day?

A. Yes! The 5<sup>th</sup> floor *SolutionsCenter* will be stocked with coffee, tea and water throughout the conference. Water stations will also be provided outside of meeting rooms.

Q. Can I check my coat and luggage?

A. Yes, on the 6<sup>th</sup> floor there is a coat/luggage check.
